FRIED BANANAS - *Solberg* [L] All gold form of 'Fragrant Bouquet'. White flowers. **\$10.**

FRIED GREEN TOMATOES - *Solberg* [L] All green form of 'Guacamole'. Vigorous grower, near white flowers. **\$10.**

FROSTED MOUSE EARS –*Zilis/ Deckert* [Mini] Green leaves with white borders and pale lavender flowers. **\$20.**

FUJIBOTAN - *Japan* [M] Medium green leaves with fully double lavender blossoms. **\$15.**

GAIJIN — *Zilis/Zumbar* [Mini] Leaves medium green lance shaped, narrow creamy yellow borders, flowers pale lavender, ideal for rock garden. **\$10.**

GOLD STANDARD - *P. Banyai* [M] Beautiful gold leaves, margined green, color holds throughout season, increases rapidly, one of the best hostas. Lavender flowers. **\$ 8.**

GREEN PIECRUST - *F. Williams* [L] Green leaves neatly ruffled on edge, lavender flowers. **\$8.**

GUACAMOLE - *Solberg* [L] Gold centered green margin. Mutation of Fragrant Bouquet. Fast grower tolerates more sun. **\$15.**

GUARDIAN ANGEL –*Thompson* [L] Large plant with intense blue-green variegation and white flowers. **\$15.**

GUM DROP – *Englerth/Ruh* [S] Green-blue version of Gold Drop with pale lavender flowers. Great for borders or ground cover. A vigorous grower. **\$8.**

GUS – *Krossa* [Mini] Small mound of green foliage. Great for borders or ground cover. **\$12.**

HADSPEN BLUE TF2X7 - *Smith/Summers/Aden* [M] Deep blue, thick subtended foliage, near-white flowers. **\$10.**

HADSPEN HERON TF2X10 - *Smith/BHHS* [S] Blue, narrow foliage, white flowers. **\$ 8.**

HADSPEN SAMPHIRE - *Smith/Ruh* [M] Leaves wide luminescent gold color early changing to chartreuse by mid summer. Lavender flowers in August and Sept. A real splash in the garden. **\$10.**

HALCYON TF1X7 - *Smith/BHHS* [M] Deep blue-green foliage, slug resistant, pale lavender flower. **\$ 8.**

HERKULES HK91 - *Klose/Ruh* [G] Huge plant, green foliage, spectacular. **\$25.**

HIRAO GRANDE - *Davidson #135/Ruh* [M] Deep green pointed leaves, upright, flowers light lavender, a worthy addition to any garden. **\$25.**

HIRAO MONUMENT – *Hirao* [L] Light green leaves with lavender pendulous flowers. **\$35.**

HOLLY’S DAZZLER – *Benedict* [M] Green leaves with lavender flowers. **\$15.**

JAMES A. GARFIELD – *Sugita/Ruh* [L] Medium green leaves with heavily rippled margins. Red petioles with deep lavender flowers. **\$25.**

JULIE MORSS - *Morss* [M] Originated in England, seedling of Frances Williams. Leaf center is light gold in spring with chartreuse and green margins. 12" high. Color holds in shade. White flowers. Few know this handsome plant. **\$10.**

JUMBO – *Summers/Meissner* [L] Very large blue, green leaves with thick substance and near white flowers. **\$50.**

JUNE - *Neo Plants LTD* [M] A golden Halcyon with green edge, pale lavender flowers. **\$15.**

KING JAMES – *Krossa/Summers* [L] Large upright blue-green plant with thick substance and pale lavender flowers. **\$23.**

KING MICHAEL – *Krossa/Summers* [L] Large upright green plant with near white flowers. **\$20.**

KING TUT—*Harshbarger* [L] Chartreuse leaves early on which soon turn yellow, light lavender flowers. **\$12.**

KLOPPING VARIEGATED – *Klopping/Ruh* [M] Blue-gray heart shaped leaves, pale yellow to white edge. Wonderful border plant. **\$8.**

KOMODO DRAGON – *Seaver* [L] Green leaves with undulated margins, lavender flowers. **\$18.**

KROSSA REGAL - *G. Krossa/A. Krossa* [L] Leaf of blue-gray on tall leaf stems, vase shaped, a regal plant, flowers soft orchid, tall scapes, should be in every collection. **\$10.**

LADY GUINEVERE – *Heemskerk* [M] Gold centers with green margins and pale lavender flowers. **\$20.**

LAKE CHAUTAUQUA - *Sugita/Ruh* [L] Blue-green leaves which are scalloped, twisted and waxy. 35' scapes, lavender flowers. Named for our favorite lake in New York. **\$35.**

LAKE ONTARIO – *Lydell* [M] Green leaf with white flowers. **\$12.**

LAKESIDE KALEIDESCOPE -*Chastain* [M] Green leaves with wide white margins and some streaking, near white flowers. **\$12.**

LAKESIDE LEPRECHAUN – *Chastain* [M] Wide mound of multicolored chartreuse, gold and green leaves with near white flowers. **\$18.**

LAVENDER STOCKINGS - *Sugita/Ruh* [M-L] Grey-green leaves with white backs, lavender petioles, Pale lavender flowers. Choice. **\$35.**

LEMON LIME - *Savory* [S] Chartreuse-yellow leaves form a tight mound, excellent edger. **\$ 8.**

LEOLA FRAIM – *Lachman* [M] Variegated green and white leaves with lavender flowers. **\$10.**

LEPRECHAUN-DSM15– *Stone/Ruh* [Mini] Small green plant with dark violet flowers. **\$10.**

LIBERTY – *J. Machen, Jr.* [L] Sport of Sagae, wide yellow margins, lavender flowers. Spectacular specimen plant. **\$18.**

LINDE - *Hofer* [L] Blue, green leaves with lots of puckering and lavender flowers. Stunning. **\$25.**

LITTLE WIGGLER – *Lachman/Ruh* [S] F1 gracillima, narrow, green, elegant leaves, lavender flowers. Vigorous grower, ideal border plant. **\$ 8.**

LUNAR MAGIC - *Lydell* [M] Medium leaves with green and gold foliage and lavender flowers. **\$12.**

MAPLE LEAF - *Minks* [L] Stately, larger form of Frances Williams. Striking specimen. **\$20.**

MARIE CURIE – *Hensen* [L] Moderately corrugated with slightly wavy leaves and pale lavender flowers. **\$50.**

MAY – *Hansen* [M] An all gold version of June with lavender flowers. **\$12.**

MIDWEST MAGIC – *Zilis* [M] Wide, gold centered leaves with green edge, pale lavender flowers. **\$10.**

MIKI – *Sugita/Ruh* [L] Named for H. Sugita's daughter. Open growth, medium yellow cross of T6601 and T6602 (Hirao Japanese Hybrid). Medium violet flower. Spectacular. **\$20.**

MILLENNIUM – *Wilkins* [L] Blue, green leaves which change to dark green late in season with pale lavender flowers on tall scapes. **\$15.**

MOLLY – *Ruh* [L] Found by Tim Ruh in a block of Krossa Regal. Blue-green leaves with yellow borders, upright growth with lavender flowers. **\$15.**

MONTANA AUREOMARGINATA – *Japan/AHS* [L] Large, green, leaves with a broad yellow edge and pale lavender flowers. Likes a little sun. **\$10.**

MONTANA CHODAI GINYO – *Japan* [L] Montana type, blue green leaves, lavender flowers. **\$25.**

NESMITH'S GIANT – *Nesmith/Ruh* [L] Corrugated green leaves with near white flowers. **\$10.**

NEW WAVE – *Zilis/Lohman* [S] Lime, green foliage with thick substance and pale lavender flowers. **\$10.**

NIGHT BEFORE CHRISTMAS — *Machen* [M] Sport of white Christmas, wide dark green leaves with a clear white center. Lavender flowers early summer. **\$10.**

NIGRESCENS - *Species* [L] Handsome plant, bluish-green to green, cupped and corrugated leaves, bloom scape to five feet. Lavender flowers. **\$10.**

OH MY HEART – *Lydell* [M] Deep green leaves, with heavy lavender flowers on scape just above the leaves. **\$35.**

OPIPARA - *Japan* [L] Shiny dark green leaf with bright yellow margin with purple flowers. **\$18.**

PANDORA'S BOX – *Hansen/Shady Oaks* [Mini] Tiny green and white sport of Baby Bunting with purple flowers. **\$18.**

PARKY'S PRIZE — *Hawes/Summers* [M] New sport of Birchwood Parky's Gold, dark green leaves with yellow edge. Lavender flowers. Vigorous grower. **\$12.**

PATRIOT - *Machen* [M] Sport of Francee, dark green leaves, wide white margins violet flowers. **\$10.**

PAULEY – [S] Small yellow foliage with purple flowers. **\$15.**

PAUL'S GLORY - *Hofer/Ruh* [M] Our most outstanding hosta, large leaf with bright yellow center and 1/2" blue-green border. Color holds entire season. Lavender flowers. **\$15.**

PERRY'S TRUE BLUE — *Hofer, Ruh* [L] Sieboldiana type with very large steel blue leaves which are puckered and heavy ribbed. Slow upright grower. Lavender-white flowers. **\$12.**

PETER PAN — *N.Minks* [S] Slightly cupped gray-green leaves on compact mound. Lavender flowers. **\$ 8.**

PETER RUH – *Zilis/Ruh* [L] Blue green leaf with yellow cream edge and pale lavender flowers. **\$25.**

PINEAPPLE POLL – *Smith/BHHS* [M] *H. lancifolia* x *sieboldiana* cross with lavender flowers and robust growth. **\$8.**

PLANTAGINEA – *Japan* [M] Light green, shiny leaves with stunning fragrant white flowers. **\$8.**

POPO -O'Hara/Riehl [Mini] Blue-green leaves, compact, lavender flowers. **\$10.**

X-RAY – *Simmering* [Mini] Small variegated plant with purple flowers. **\$18.**

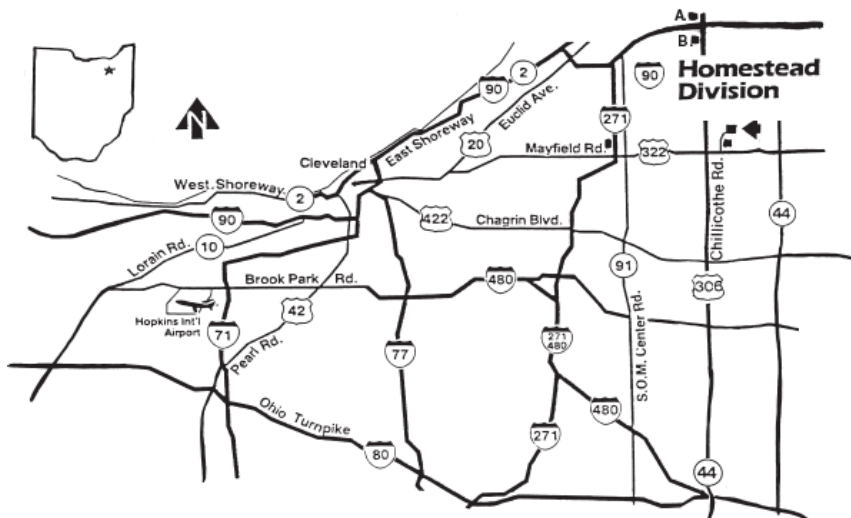
